Project Description

HCH Manchester offers medical care, substance abuse counseling, case management, health education, and nursing outreach to homeless persons. Through long-standing partnerships, HCH Manchester extends its reach beyond Manchester, facilitating assistance and access to care for people throughout the State.

Services

HCH outreach clinics are based at two sites. New Horizons for New Hampshire is the State's largest emergency shelter for single men and women, and Families In Transition is a supportive housing program providing Intensive Case Management for families and older single women. Nursing outreach and health education are conducted at these two sites and at several smaller shelters, homeless service agencies, and at a teen drop-in center.

Linkages

HCH Manchester has extensive linkages with agencies throughout the State to provide health care and social services. These supports come from State, local and private entities, as well as academic institutions.

Project Description

Two mobile health teams travel within a 100 square mile area, visiting shelters, soup kitchens, camp grounds, and other isolated areas frequented by individuals who are homeless. The team consists of a project coordinator, nurse, nurse practitioner, alcohol/substance abuse counselor, care coordinator, and mental health counselor.

Services

Services include primary medical care, medication, substance abuse counseling and referrals, laboratory and diagnostic testing, oral health treatment and referral, immunizations, medical/social care coordination, health education, eligibility screening, and tracking and follow-up through an electronic medical records system.

Linkages

Linkages include health and social service agencies (AIDS Response-Seacoast, Alliance for Community

Health, Stafford Network), shelters (Cross Roads House, My Friend's Place, Rochester Overflow Shelter, A Safe Place, New Generation), community health centers (Avis Goodwin CHC, Lamprey Health Care), hospitals (Exeter, Portsmouth Regional, Frisbie, Wentworth-Douglass), mental health centers (Seacoast Mental Health/Community Partners), a network of volunteer physicians and dentists administered by SeaCare Health Services, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Continuum of Care (United Way of the Greater Seacoast, City of Portsmouth), and outreach (Rockingham Community Action, Strafford Community Action).
