

# **Circle the City**


Phoenix, Arizona Program Snapshot July 2014

Circle the City (CTC) is a 50-bed, freestanding medical respite center serving the greater Phoenix area. This year, CTC will provide more than 300 unique individuals with comprehensive care including primary medical services, behavioral health and substance abuse therapy, psychiatric assessment and stabilization, and case management services. CTC opened in October 2012. Since opening, CTC has discharged more than 80% of all patients somewhere other than the streets or emergency shelter system.


### **Average Occupancy** 36 of 50 beds
